Victor John Paradis was born July 29, 1918 in Vallers Twp., Lyon County, MN to Henry and Theresa (Hirmer) Paradis. He grew up and attended school in Marshall, MN. He served in the U.S. Navy from 1941 to 1946 and was one of 3 remaining Pearl Harbor Survivors in Minnesota. On November 4, 1946 he married Lucille Marie Langan in Marshall. Victor worked at the power plant in Marshall until 1948 when he and Lucille moved to Mankato where he was Engineer Assistant Superintendent for NSP until 1984. He was a member of the Pearl Harbor Survivors for many years and traveled 7 states as the 5th District Director from 1986 to 1990. He enjoyed bowling, golf, growing tomatoes, card playing, calling bingo, and dancing with Lucille.

He is survived by his wife of 72 years, Lucille, North Mankato; sons; Wayne (Randy) Paradis, Kamiah, ID, Bruce (Lisa) Paradis, Eden Prairie, MN, Thomas (Molly Lowe), Mankato, MN; daughter, Janice (Steve) Nelson, Woodbury, MN; 15 grandchildren; 24 great grandchildren; 1 great-great grandchild; many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, 4 brothers and 2 sisters.
